



Canadian Hereford Ambassador Award

To recognize persons, family operations, or businesses that are non-residents of Canada, and/or non members, which have made a major contribution to the promotion of Canadian Hereford genetics. The Canadian Hereford Association Board of Directors shall consider on an annual basis the selection of a deserving person or organization for the award.

Eligibility

Any person or persons, family operation or business being non-residents of Canada and/or a non-member of the Canadian Hereford Association that have made a significant contribution to the promotion of Canadian Genetics.

Nominations

1. Nominations must be received by the Canadian Hereford Association office prior to January 1st of each year, and will be reviewed and selected at the February Board meeting.
2. Successful nominee will be presented with an award at the Annual General Meeting or one of the National Shows of the Association.
3. A full description of the merits and contributions of the nominee must be provided to the Association.
4. A request for nomination will occur in the June Newsletter to the membership.

Selection

1. The Canadian Hereford Association staff will review the submissions to ensure there is a full description of the contributions of each nominee.
2. The Board will consider the nominees at the February Board meeting and make their selection(s).

Communications and Recognitions

1. Award recipients will be included in the Annual Report of the Association.
2. Award recipients will be recognized at either the Annual General Meeting or at one of the National Shows of the Association.
3. A suitable gift will be presented to each award recipient at the time of the presentation of the award.
4. A press release will be done at the time of the presentation of the award.
