Herefords Conquer the Competition at Calgary Bull Sale

The Canadian Hereford Association is pleased to announce that at the **107th Annual Calgary Bull Sale**, March 7 & 8th, 2007 **Herefords conquered the other breeds**.

Michael Parrent of JoNomn Hereford Ranch, Clyde, Alberta had the **Grand Champion Hereford and High Seller** with his bull JNHR Red Standard 68R. Parrent's bull sold for **\$40,000** to Doenz Ranches of Warner, AB and Floyd Anderson Herefords of Cardston, AB, bringing **over \$25,000** more than any bull of another breed.

The Reserve Grand Champion Hereford bull, SFL 86M Robin 99R, consigned by Murray Stauffer of Stauffer Farms Ltd., Eckville, AB was also the second highest-selling animal of all breeds, fetching an impressive \$16,500 from Gordon & Neal Church of Balzac.

Herefords also dominated in the averages, with 134 bulls consigned and a sale average of \$3,945.52 (100 bulls and \$450 and 50 bulls and \$300 better than Charolais and Angus numbers and sale averages, respectively).

The stellar results were also part of a timely trend, which saw the average Hereford sale price increase by almost \$200 from the 2006 sale.
